

SENIOR GAMES

General Information

A non-refundable registration fee of \$6.00 will be charged to all participants registering for the Senior Games. Registration is requested by September 1st for Biking, Bowling, Golf, Swimming, Shuffleboard, 5K and Horseshoes. Registration is encouraged in advance for other events, but can be done on-site the day of the event.

Registration Fee

Entitles Senior Games participants to:

- Participation in all Senior Games (some events have special fees)
- Awards to top three participants in each age category for each event
- T-Shirt to first 100 **pre-registered** participants

Special Fees

Additional fee required for Golf paid at Elmbrook Golf Course. Additional fee of \$6/person for bowlers not enrolled in at least one other Games event. \$2 each for Miniature Golf at Wilderness Crossings to be paid on-site.

Sign-In

All Senior Games participants should arrive 30 minutes prior to start time of their event. Upon registering participants will receive a numbered name tag, and itinerary for the day.
