TOUR ITINERARY – WASHINGTON, DC AND BALTIMORE

AUGUST 23-29, 2010

- **Sun. Aug. 23** - Tour departs Traverse City Senior Center at 6:15 am sharp. Dress casual and comfortable - today is a travel day; rest and meal breaks will be made every 2-3 hours. 6:00 pm arrival Monroeville, PA Holiday Inn (local phone (412) 372-1022), a full service Holiday Inn with a restaurant and lounge for guests' convenience. There is also a Max 'n Erma's within easy walking distance of the hotel. (those who have been on our theater trips know how delicious they are).
- **Mon. Aug. 24** - 6:15 am breakfast buffet starts in Madison's restaurant in the hotel. 7:15 am bags out. 7:45 am depart for Washington DC. 12:00 pm arrive in DC; fast-food lunch enroute. 1:00 pm Arlington National Cemetery for the tourmobile to the Tomb of the Unknowns, Kennedy Grave, and Arlington House. Following the Arlington tour, the coach will stop at the Iwo Jima Memorial, then proceed to the Holiday Inn Capitol (local phone number (202) 479-4000). Coach will depart the Holiday Inn Capitol at 4:45 pm for the Lazy Susan Dinner Theatre - a Pennsylvania Dutch Buffet - and the production of "Beehive", a lively tribute to the ladies of Rock and Pop during the decade of 1960s. We return to the Holiday Inn immediately following the conclusion of the play.
- **Tues. Aug. 25** - Breakfast is on your own; breakfast buffet at the Smithsonian's Restaurant in the hotel or there are a few other restaurants in the neighborhood. 7:45 am coach will depart for a tour through the White House. 9:15 am coach will depart from the White House Visitor's Center and travel to the National Cathedral for a 10:00 am tour of this magnificent building. Following the tour we will make a short trip to Union Station for free time and lunch (on your own) in one of the many restaurants in the food court. Please be back on the motorcoach at 1:20 pm. Accommodations are at the Holiday Inn Capitol (same as 8/24). Dinner will be on your own, at Smithsonian's Restaurant at the hotel, or there are other restaurants in the neighborhood. 6:15 pm depart Holiday Inn Capitol for a guided tour of Washington, DC and an evening guided tour of the Memorial and monuments.
- **Wed. Aug. 26** - A coupon is included for the breakfast buffet at Smithsonian's Restaurant in the Holiday Inn Capitol. You are on your own for the day to tour the Smithsonian museums. Do check out the new Museum of the American Indian – have a really good lunch here - it is in the Capitol Mall area and near many of the Smithsonian museums. Don't forget the Smithsonian museums close at 5:30 pm. Departure for the Holiday Inn at 6:00 pm. For dinner tonight we enjoy a Washington, DC treat at Phillip's Flagship Seafood Restaurant on the Potomac River. They are known for their Crab Cakes.
- **Thurs. Aug. 27** - 6:45 am bags out. Breakfast is on your own. 7:30 am depart for Baltimore. 8:50 am arrive at Fort McHenry, the site of the Battle of Baltimore, and the inspiration for Francis Scott Key to write the "Star Spangled Banner". Our group is reserved for a 9:00 am presentation of the movie. 9:30 am change and an exhibit of the flags used at the fort. 9:50 am coach will depart Fort McHenry for downtown Baltimore and the Inner Harbor. Free time for lunch in the Inner Harbor area. If you do nothing else, try the Maryland Crab Cakes - this city is famous for them. 1:00 pm depart the Inner Harbor area for the B & O Railroad Museum, the world's largest collection of railroad artifacts; housed in a working roundhouse and 40 acre campus. 4:00 pm depart from the B & O museum
 - Accommodations at the Best Western Hotel Baltimore (local phone (410) 633-9500). Toby's Dinner Theatre of Baltimore is located in the hotel. The doors to the dinner theater open at 6:00 pm for the buffet dinner, with a play to follow. Tonight's production has not been announced.
- **Fri. Aug. 28** - 7:30 am bags out; Continental breakfast at the Best Western Hotel (included). 8:30 am depart for the National Aquarium in Baltimore. This is a self guided visit. 11:00 am Dolphin Show at the National Aquarium. 12:20 pm coach will depart the Aquarium for those not wanting to walk to Monroeville
- Our final night accommodations are at the Monroeville, PA Holiday Inn (local phone (412) 372-1022) (same as 8/23)
- **Sat. Aug. 29** - 6:45 am bags out. 6:30 am breakfast buffet in Madison's Restaurant. 7:45 am coach will depart for home. Rest breaks and meal stops along the Pennsylvania and Ohio Turnpikes as needed. 7:00 pm estimated return time to Traverse City
